The Eagle Alumni Committee of the Cradle of Liberty Council is pleased to announce that at least \$4,000 in Scholarships will be awarded in 2017 to Eagle Scouts who will be heading to college or a post-high school technical school in the fall of 2017.

Candidates must be an Eagle Scout, meaning all requirements have been met, and the Board of Review has approved the individual to be an Eagle Scout. Candidates must be graduating high school in 2017.

An Eagle Scout can apply for this scholarship himself, or his Unit Leader can nominate him. In both cases, the information below must be filled out, and returned to the Firestone Scouting Resource Center by noon on March 31, 2017. A parent cannot be the Unit Leader making a nomination.

If you are the Eagle Scout applying, you must include a 500 word essay on How becoming an Eagle Scout has helped you help others. You also need to include a letter from your Scoutmaster indicating his support of your application.

If you are a Unit Leader nominating an Eagle Scout, you must include a one-page letter on what makes this Eagle Scout special or unique. This could include special circumstances or obstacles they have overcome, an outstanding service project, a unique style of leadership they have, or something else that would make him stand out, even among other Eagle Scouts.
