College Pre-Requirements

Please review prerequisites prior to choosing the badges. Some badges have rank or time limit requirements, or require items be brought to class. Do not select a badge you do not meet requirements for. Scouts should read the Merit Badge Pamphlet prior to the first class.

When a requirement number or letter is listed, the work for that requirement must be completed prior to the first day of the college. Requirements to “write,” “list” or “record” should be done in the Merit Badge worksheets that can be found online. Other requirements may require other documentation be brought in, such as the letter to an elected official for Citizenship in the Nation.
