Step 1 — Pick a theme:

This is your chance to create whatever you can dream! Be as innovative and collaborative as possible and use your imagination.

Step 2 - Gather your materials

Start with a shoebox or any similar shaped box as your base. Add clay, paint, markers, crayons, craft supplies, feathers, sequins, flowers, seeds, toys, photos pretty much anything to bring your vision to life.

Step 3 – Watch the 6abc Dunkin Thanksgiving Celebration

Gather your family, friends and neighbors and grab your front row seat in the comfort of your own home and watch our Celebration and Philadelphia's FIRST shoebox parade!

Once your float is complete, the actual float should be submitted to the 6abc Station (Attn. John Morris) by Friday, October 2, 2020.

Once you submit your creation, it will be shot on a green screen and then animated like a parade. **Please do not use any GREEN on your float at all or it will not be able to seen on television. Once again do not have anything GREEN on your float!**

If you are building a double decker float, make sure to use support items to design your float. Dowels or popsicle sticks provide great support for your creation.
